

# Restrict resource access in Moodle based on specific criteria.

### Introduction

#### Scenario:

You want to restrict access to one resource/activity/section based on membership of a group, a date, or other criteria.

#### **Overview:**

Moodle allows you to set criteria that must be met to release resources. For example, you might want to restrict access to materials to member of a particular group, not release resources until a particular date, or restrict access after a date has passed.

### Target situations:

You want to have different materials or activities, such as forums, available to students in a particular group or grouping.

You want a separate assessment only available to a group of students.

You don't want students to view something until a particular date has passed.

You only want activities such as forum available until a particular time.

You want a complex restriction based on a specific group and a date.

### Prior knowledge required:

Know how to edit module settings.

Know how to add/edit a resource.

Know how to create groups.

#### Situations not covered by this resource:

You want the students to achieve a passing grade on a quiz or assignment before another resource is shown.

You want the students to have or have not completed another activity before another resource is shown.

You want to restrict access by categories within a student's user profile.



You want to check student completion of activities.

## How to release an activity based on group membership.

Create the activity or click on the three dots to the right of the activity you would like to restrict access to and click on the **edit settings** option that appears. Make sure you are in the **settings tab** for that activity and scroll down to find the **restrict access** section. Click on the button to **'add restriction'.**

### How to release an activity based on date.

Create the activity or click on the three dots to the right of the activity you would like to restrict access to and click on the **edit settings** option that appears. Make sure you are in the **settings tab** for that activity and scroll down to find the **restrict access** section. Click on the button to **'add restriction'.**

**Add restriction** will allow you to set an end date if you want to limit the time an activity or assessment is available. Note: In this example I wanted the quiz to close at midnight at the end of January 30<sup>th</sup> so it is set to July 31<sup>st</sup> 00:00. You can see this in the later screenshot.
